## **Pension & Retirement Education Program (PREP)**

Members of the New York State Teachers' Retirement System (NYSTRS) who are approaching retirement often tell us they wish they had begun focusing on financial and retirement planning much earlier in their lives. The truth is: No matter how far along you are in your career, careful financial and retirement planning are critical!

With this in mind, NYSTRS is introducing a new program for members of all ages, the **Pension & Retirement Education Program (PREP)**. PREP seminars are free, and sessions are held throughout the year and across the state.

This program will offer the same type of information as the Retirement Planning Seminars we held in the past, but members can tailor PREP to fit their needs. They can stay for the entire seminar (from 8:30 a.m. - 3 p.m.) or just those modules that help them the most: NYSTRS benefits; financial planning; Social Security; estate planning; filing for retirement; adjusting to retirement; and retirement income.
